

Are there any solar energy storage plants in Algeria



Overview

Construction has started on two solar plants in Algeria that form part of the country's energy transition programme. The Government of Algeria sees ideal opportunities of combining Algeria's richest fossil energy source – the natural gas – with Algeria's most abundant renewable energy source – the sun – by integrating concentrating solar power into natural gas combined cycles. The first of the two projects is in Bir Naam, Biskra province. Sonelgaz has signed 19 contracts with local and international companies to construct solar PV plants across Algeria. Algeria has also joined the Desertec Industrial Initiative, which aims to use Sahara solar and wind power to supply 15 per cent of. The policy framework focuses on three pillars: The 80MW photovoltaic plant with 20MWh battery storage achieved: Recent updates to Algeria's Renewable Energy Law 2022-07 introduce: Combine storage solutions with existing infrastructure – many Oran projects retrofit old gas plants into hybrid energy.
