Overview

Wind turbines operate solely on natural wind power without the need for external fuel inputs. Wind energy is a form of renewable energy, typically powered by the movement of wind across enormous fan-shaped structures called wind turbines. Once built, these turbines create no climate-warming greenhouse gas emissions, making this a “carbon-free” energy source that can provide electricity. Today, wind power is generated almost completely using wind turbines, generally grouped into wind farms and connected to the electrical grid. In 2025, wind supplied about 2,700 TWh of electricity, which was over 8% of world electricity. Concerns about bird deaths, property values, and health effects dominate local planning meetings.
