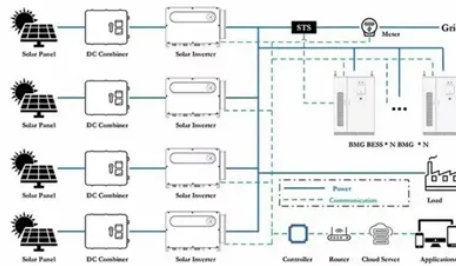


Namibia based control energy storage battery



Overview

Namibia intends to solve these problems in the future with a “battery energy storage system” (BESS).
