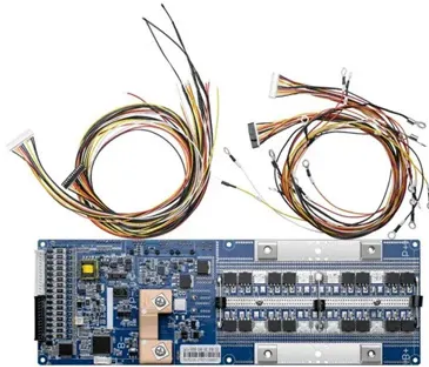


Solar photovoltaic panels in series

Solar Panel arrays are usually limited by one factor, the charge controller. Charge controllers are only designed to accept a certain amount of amperage and voltage. Often times for 1A. The total current, voltage, and power vary specific to the connection mode. To sum up: 1. Series Connection: Current stays constant, voltage adds up. 2. Parallel Connection: Voltage stays constant, current adds up.

Shading Solar Panels Series or Parallel

What happens if a solar panel is partially shaded? The current of the solar panel that is shaded will drop significantly, reducing the total current output of the whole series string.
